Jesus in His Place?

***Prayer is communication with Supernatural Expectations.***

This week's key passage. **Colossians 1:15-19**

Praying we keep Jesus in His proper place.

1. Praying that Jesus is preeminent in our homes.
  - “Lord, help us to keep You as the central focus of our families. May we not be distracted by the static that arises from the busyness of our lives. May we point our spouses, children, and grandchildren to You. We decide today to put You before all things in our families.” **Genesis 18:17-19**
  
2. Praying that Jesus is preeminent in our churches.
  - “Lord, speak through Your Holy Spirit to those that lead churches around the world. May they declare You as the head of the church. May these leaders be faithful to lift You up, or may they be replaced by those who will, because You are the head of the church.” **Ephesians 5:23-24a** **Jeremiah 10:21**
  
3. Praying that Jesus is preeminent in our culture.
  - “Lord, we long to see our culture return to You. We desire that You will be our first thought not our last resort in this generation. Help us, as Your people seek You first and may our desire for Your leadership stir the unsaved around us to seek You.” **1 Peter 2:12**
  
4. Praying that Jesus is preeminent in our leadership.
  - “Lord, we desire righteous godly leaders to be in authority over us. May those that You place into positions over us seek You above all things. We pray for those who know You as their Savior, that they will not be caught up in the corruption of power but that they recognize You as their true leader. May those who do not know You be saved and follow You completely.”
