This week's key passage. **Revelation 3:7-13**

Learning from the message to Philadelphia

1. Praying we realize Jesus' authority and power.
 - “Lord Jesus, You are the One who has the right, power and authority over everyone. You are holy and true. You and You alone Lord, have the keys that open and close opportunities for Your Kingdom purposes. We know that no one can close a door You have opened or open a door You have closed.” **Revelation 3:1-2**
2. Praying that we see what is in front of us.
 - “Lord, You have opened doors before us that we can hardly understand. Give us eyes to behold every door that You have opened and help us to boldly walk through each of them. We are people of little strength, but You perfect strength through our weakness. May we, by the power of the Holy Spirit keep Your word and never deny Your name.” **Revelation 3:8**
3. Praying we are reminded that God is at work.
 - “Lord You are at work even when we are unaware of what You are doing. Those who are tools of Satan yield to Your authority. Some say that they are Yours and are not, yet you will cause them all to bow before You. Jesus You have loved us and Your love for us is evident for all the world to see. You are coming again, and we intend to hold fast to what You have entrusted to us.” **Revelation 3:9-11**
4. Praying as overcomers.
 - “Jesus we intend to be overcomers. We desire what You will give to us as overcomers more than anything that the world could give us. We long for constant worship of You in Your temple. We long to be called by Your name and dwell where You dwell. We hear what You are saying to the church through Your Spirit.” **Revelation 3:12**
