Praying for a Remedy

***Prayer is communication with Supernatural Expectations.***

This week's key passage. **2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 21**

Praying that God's people see the remedy.

1. Praying that God will continue to reach out to His people.
  - “Lord, we know that in Your compassion You have faithfully tried to draw Your people back to You. We have heard Your call over and over again, yet we have not responded. God, please speak to us again and move our hearts to respond as we should.” **2 Chronicles 36:15**
  
2. Praying that we will no longer ignore God's clear message.
  - “Lord, move our hearts to respond to Your message. Your message is clear, yet our responses in the past have been a mockery of Your name. We have despised Your Word and continued in our own ways. May we heed Your warnings and repent of our unfaithfulness and turn and follow You.” **2 Chronicles 36:16a**
  
3. Praying that we understand there is a time of no remedy.
  - “Lord, we know that You have been longsuffering with us. We have seen Your gracious compassion upon us for far longer than we deserve. We also understand that if we fail to repent and turn to You that You may bring Your wrath upon us and that we may reach the point that there is no remedy for us as a nation. We ask that You move mightily among Your people. Stir our hearts to return to You before it is too late.” **2 Chronicles 36:16b**
  
4. Praying we understand that Your Word will be fulfilled.
  - “Lord, we know that Your Word will ultimately be fulfilled. What You say will come to pass regardless of our actions. May we live our lives in a way that allows for Your Word to be fulfilled through us, not against us. We want our land to flourish, not become desolate.” **2 Chronicles 36:21**
