Prayer is communication with Supernatural Expectations.

This week's key passage. **Revelation 2:1-7**

Learning from the message to Ephesus

1. Praying we realize that Jesus message is powerful! *"In His right hand"*
 - "Lord Jesus, we desire to hear from You. We ask that You give us ears to hear Your powerful message. Deliver Your message to us through the messenger that You have ordained for the church. May the power of that message move us to the work that You have for us to do in our generation!" **Revelation 2:1**
2. Praying that we don't allow activity to override love. *"Nevertheless... left thy first love "*
 - "Lord far too often we have allowed what we do for You to lose the passion of why we do it. May we never see busyness as the goal. Help us to do everything we do for Your Kingdom through a heart that is motivated by the great love that You demonstrated for us. We desire to serve You because You loved us first and we want others to know Your great love." **Revelation 2:2-4**
3. Praying that we change. *Remember, repent, and redo*
 - "Jesus we long to be restored. Help us to remember where we came from. Give us the clarity to recall the love that You showed to us when You redeemed us. May we show that love to all we encounter. We repent of our sin. We confess that we have become too ritualistic in our worship and our service. We will go back and redo what You have sent us to do. We will through the strength of Your Holy Spirit do the first works You have called us to. **Revelation 2:5**
4. Praying we will overcome and live. *"To him that overcometh...eat of the tree of life"*
 - "Heavenly Father, our hearts desire is to be the Church You have called us to be. We understand that You intend for us to be overcomers, but that depends on us. You have given us life eternal in the future and abundant life now. May we spend our days living in the love You have shown us, and may we share the message of life with everyone we meet." **Revelation 2:7**
