- 1. Praying we understand that Jesus knows our works. "I know thy works"
 - "Father, we know that You are totally aware of our works as a church. Nothing that we do is hidden from You. You know the things that we do that are right. You know the areas where we fall short of doing Your will in Your way. Help us to work, understanding that You know our works."

- 2. Praying that we hear what You are saying to our Church. "He that hath an ear let him hear"
